Criteria for Selection

#### Rules and Requirements

1. Definition: Young Optometrist- those who have been in practice less than 10 years.
2. Show remarkable leadership skills when serving their profession, their patients, and their community.
3. Must be a member of MOA and AOA
4. Nominees will be accepted from any MOA member or Local Society.
5. All Nominations must be post marked by October 5, 2007 in order to be considered.
6. Nomination will be considered by the Nomination and Awards Committee or a Special Committee appointed by the MOA President.
7. The nominee's may be assigned a maximum of 100 points.
8. In the event that no suitable nominee is selected, no award will be given that year.

#### Criteria

1. Service to Optometry **(40 point maximum)**
  - Leadership Roles: list all positions held and dates in State, Local and National Optometric organizations.
  - Major Accomplishments
2. Service to the visual welfare of the public **(35 point maximum)**
  - List Sight Saving Groups involved in, (i.e., Vision USA, Vosh, Lion Clubs, etc.
  - List any solo public service efforts (vision screening, public speaking, etc.)
  - Legislative Efforts.
3. Public Service **(25 point Maximum)**
  - List services in political, public health, military, alumni, civic, religious, etc.
